Kaimahi and Year 4-6 tamariki must wear masks in the classroom, it is optional outside. We are operating 3 teaching bubbles (Piwakawaka-Y1/2, Koutoku-Y3/4 and Karearea-Y5/6) and our Office bubble. All whanau who wish to come to school must visit the office.

When dropping tamariki off at school the gate by the office is the only entry and will be open at 8:30am, we start school at 8:50am. At the end of the day we will exit by the office gate from 2:45pm. The best place to pick up tamariki is by parking in the KMART

carpark. Please do not drive up our driveway/staff carpark.

Some other start of the year reminders are...

- Sun hats are needed in Term 1/4 (any sun hat is fine).
- Water bottles are needed for tamariki each day.
- Please make sure tamariki have their uniform and stationery labeled with their name.
- Free & Healthy lunches, free fruit (Thank-you Kelston Countdown) and healthy snacks (Thank-you KidsCan) are all available at school.
- We are not swimming at the moment to avoid any possible COVID-19 transmission.
- Our Breakfast Club is closed at Red.
- There will be no Bible-in-schools at Red


